## MANA DINING HALL

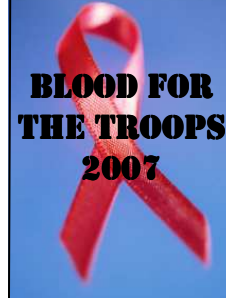
